Mrs. Isaacs' Remarks

Mrs. Isaacs started with talking about the competitive environment that the children are brought up in, and that it was up to the parents and teachers to work in tandem to ensure a happy and joyful childhood for them. While the school provides academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, the focus for each child need not only be academics; they must strive to be the best they can in any field.

Children also need to be taught to be more resilient and accept situations; to pick themselves up and move on.

Social Media, strong comparisons and a plethora of pressures on several fronts makes the children emotionally fragile. They must be guided to love themselves and be strong.

Mrs. Isaacs then addressed the issue of college admissions.

She started with relating a recent incident where a student opted to forgo his foreign university acceptances to pursue undergraduate degree in India and possibly further studies abroad. While going abroad for undergraduate studies is definitely a good (but expensive) option, Mrs. Isaacs said that there were excellent opportunities available in India for Undergraduate studies. She then presented the list of worldwide College acceptances as well as Financial Aid/ Scholarships for the current batch.

The IB as well as the ISC sections had both had very good placements.

Mrs. Isaacs clarified there had been no decision to modify the summer holiday calendar. Holidays for the ICSE/ISC and IGCSE/IB remain as they were respectively.

Mrs. Isaacs informed the parents that the air-conditioning work is ongoing in the Junior, Middle & Senior schools.

She then thanked the PTA for their good work and goodwill.
