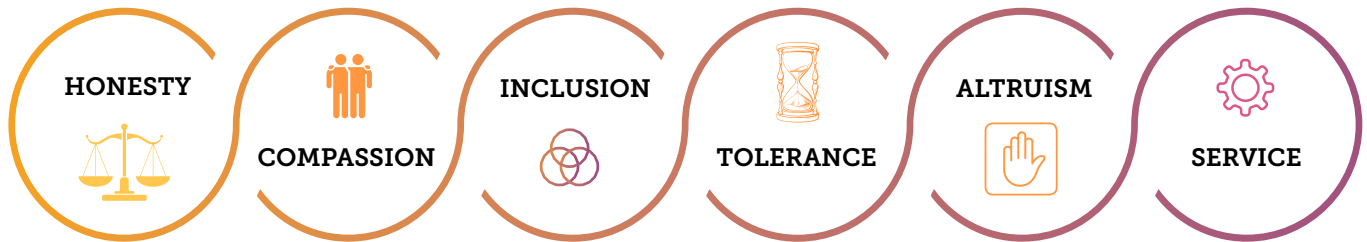

The new IB programme will bring in international learning combined with the School's core values

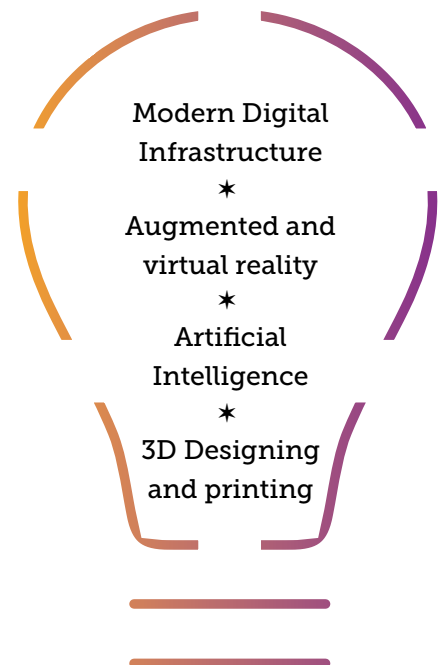




THOMAS HOUSE WILL BE THE SIXTH CAMPUS BUILDING
