ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The Cathedral & John Connon School is an Anglican foundation dating in its present form to 1860. It has its origins as a choir school which was created to provide choristers for St Thomas's Cathedral (the Mother Church of the Diocese of Bombay). The links of the School to its fountainhead, St. Thomas's Cathedral is kept alive with the annual Founders' Day service and the Christmas Carol service held in the Cathedral church (which was completed in the year 1718). In more recent times the pre-primary section of the School has returned to the precincts of the Cathedral church.

CAJCS is founded along the lines of the British Public School system. Illustrious alumni have lived up to the School's motto, "Clarum efficiunt studia" In many ways the School has mirrored the transformation of Bombay from seven sleepy fishing hamlets to the present day bustling financial capital of India. In the words of the School Song, a City which is truly, "Prima in Indis".

The Cathedral & John Connon School, ranking among the top schools in the country, prides itself in creating fine young men and women who go on to excel in diverse disciplines. But above all they bear the hallmark of a quality "Cathedral education". They embody in no small measure all that is "true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent and praiseworthy."

SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

The school's grading system is very conservative. The school grades are approximately 10% lower than the grades in the Board Exams. IBDP students are not permitted 4 HL subjects.


